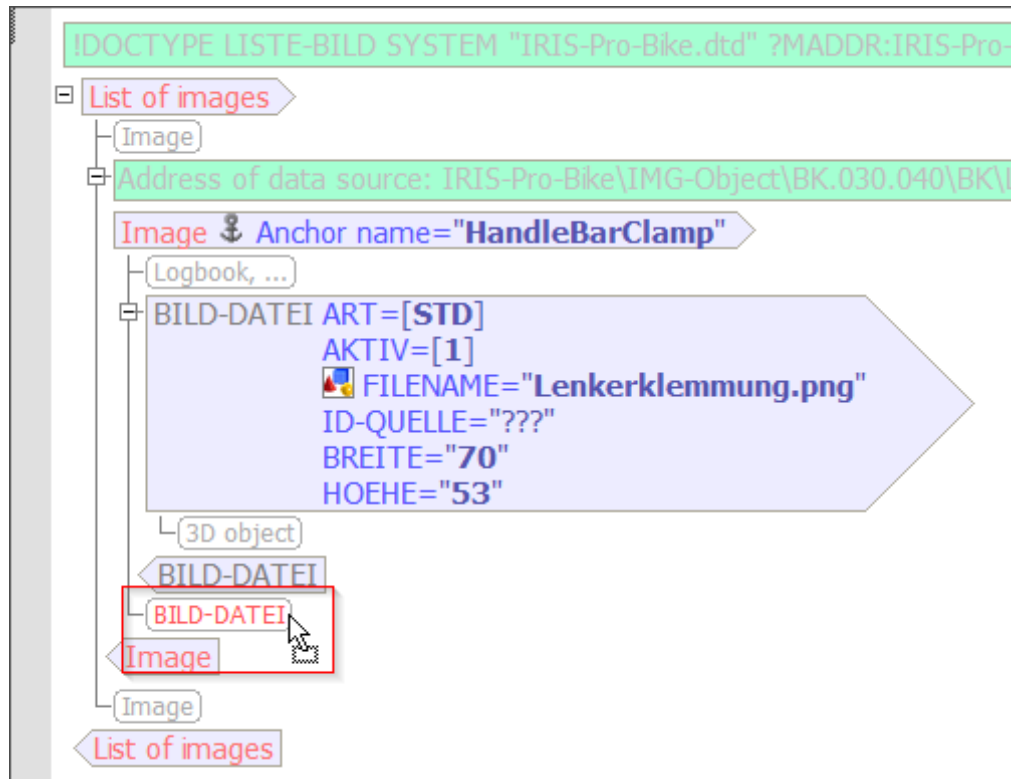

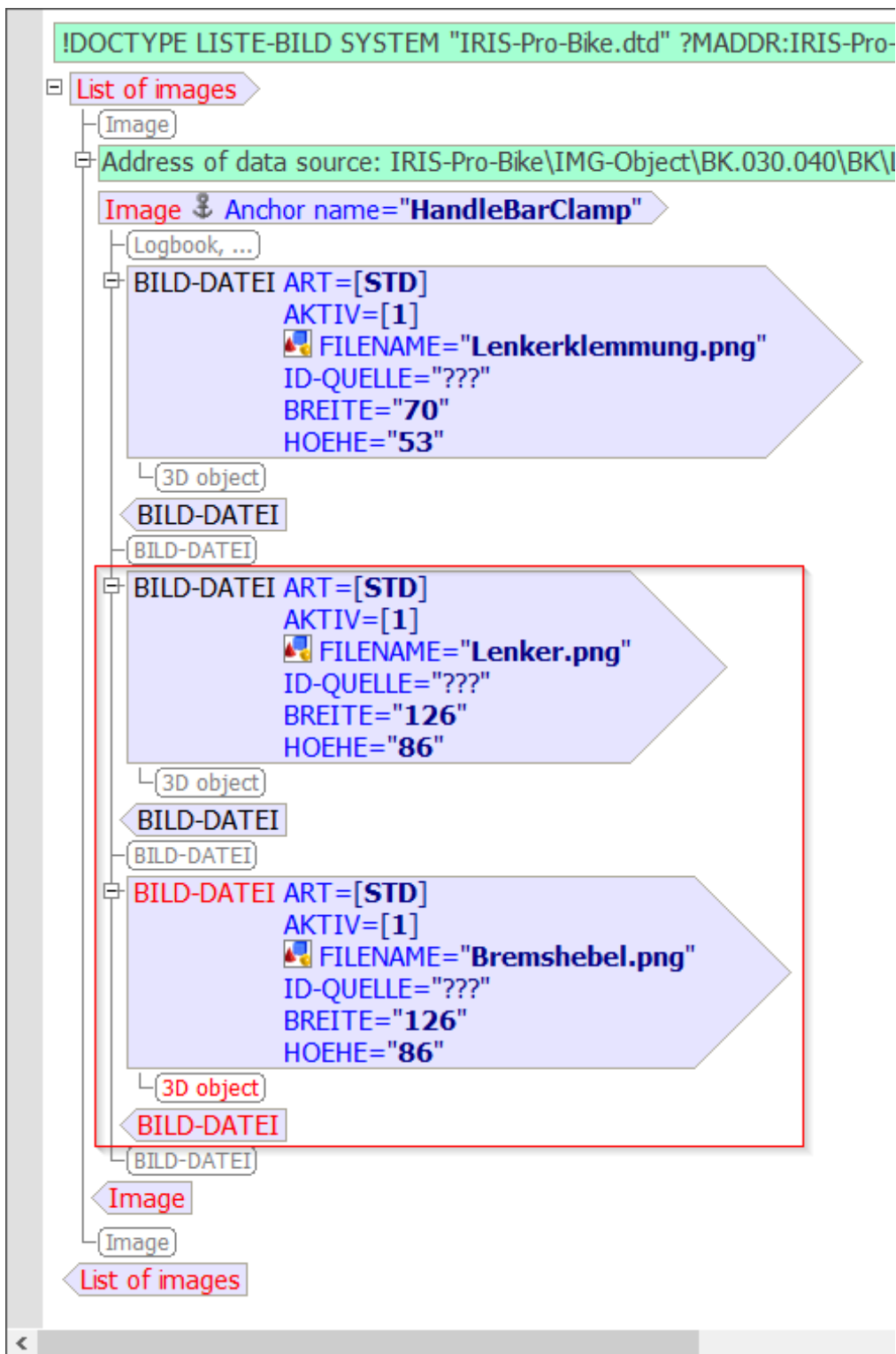


1 Change Descriptions

1.1 GRIPS Editor

1.1.1 Improved insertion of images via Drag & Drop





The insertion of images via Drag & Drop was improved in the GRIPS Editor.

Previously, you could already store one or more images from the file system (e.g., from Windows Explorer) on an insertion tag at the top level withing an IU. A separate IU anchor is created for each image; the image itself is inserted at the second-highest level of the structure, with file name and size. The respective anchor name is automatically generated from the file name of the individual image.

The IRIS structures for images have been revised, and the GRIPS Editor adapted accordingly. If your GRIPS project has these structures, you can now also record one or more images *within* individual image IU anchors. To do so, simply drag image files to the inner insertion tag (see image). The IU anchor remains unchanged, and the images are stored individually under the anchor. This allows multiple images to be saved under an anchor name, which makes it easier to link different views of the same object, for example.

1.1.2 Variable file paths of the GRIPS Editor profiles

The file paths of the GRIPS Editor profiles can now be changed via the file Grips.ini. As a result, the user can now determine where the profiles are stored.

1.2 GRIPS Viewer

1.2.1 Links to imported PDF files

When importing PDF files, the GRIPS Viewer now also includes the links contained in the PDF (i.e. cross-references to content in the PDF) . This new functionality only applies if the entire PDF file is imported in one piece.

2 Bug fixes and other adjustments

2.1 GRIPS Matrix bug fixes

2.1.1 Cockpit: Conversion when saving/loading Cockpit data

When saving the Cockpit data to GRIPS, the SQL server converts Unicode characters, such as the '&', into character strings according to the ISO standard (e.g., '&#38;'). These special characters will be converted back after loading, by which avoiding publication errors.

2.1.2 Cockpit: Attention to the edited version when creating publication lists

Creating publication lists from the '**All publications**' (Dialog '**Publications**') tab was only performed on the current database. The edited version entered in the Cockpit publication has not yet been considered. This has been corrected and the respective edited version is now loaded.

In addition, the Cockpit publication will be given the publication address as the address of the edited version; previously, this information was not stored in Cockpit.

2.2 GRIPS Viewer bug fixes

2.2.1 Improved import of bookmarks

The integration of existing PDF bookmarks during PDF import was improved.

2.3 GRIPS licensing bug fixes

2.3.1 Improved validation of GRIPS Floating Licenses

If there is a problem with a GRIPS Floating License communicating with the server, the license is temporarily declared invalid, and the polling interval is shorted from 5 minutes to one.

If, after this process, the communication with the server continues to fail, it has so far been that there was no thorough review of the floating license, but only a message was displayed that the license was invalid. Now, a new test is carried out and, if necessary, the cause for a renewed failure reported.

2.4 General adjustments

2.4.1 Crashes prevented under Windows 10

An update of Microsoft Windows 10 caused crashes in the GRIPS memory manager. The problem has been solved.
